These risk behaviors 1...

Unintentional Injuries and Violence

8% Rarely or never wore safety belts

33% Rode with a drinking driver during the past month

16% Carried a weapon during the past month

32% Were in a physical fight during the past year

11% Attempted suicide during the past year

Alcohol and Other Drug Use

43% Drank alcohol during the past month

26% Reported episodic heavy drinking during the past month

20% Used marijuana during the past month

12% Ever used cocaine

12% Ever used inhalants

Sexual Behaviors

51% Ever had sexual intercourse

16% Ever had four or more sex partners

36% Had sexual intercourse during the past three months

38% Did not use a condom during last sexual intercourse 2

88% Did not use birth control pills during last sexual intercourse²

Tobacco Use

59% Ever tried cigarette smoking

24% Smoked cigarettes during the past month

8% Smoked cigarettes on ≥ 20 days during the past month

7% Used smokeless tobacco during the past month

15% Smoked cigars during the past month

Dietary Behaviors

82% Ate < 5 servings of fruits and vegetables per day during the past 7 days

89% Drank < 3 glasses of milk per day during the past 7 days

Physical Activity

40% Participated in insufficient vigorous physical activity ³

80% Participated in insufficient moderate physical activity 4

48% Were not enrolled in physical education class

70% Did not attend physical education class daily

11% Did not participate in any vigorous or moderate physical activity

Overweight

16% At risk for becoming overweight⁵


