These risk behaviors ¹...

Unintentional Injuries and Violence

- 20% Rarely or never wore safety belts
- 36% Rode with a drinking driver during the past month
- NA² Carried a weapon during the past month
- 27% Were in a physical fight during the past year
- 9% Attempted suicide during the past year

Alcohol and Other Drug Use

- 50% Drank alcohol during the past month
- 38% Reported episodic heavy drinking during the past month
- 22% Used marijuana during the past month
- 7% Ever used cocaine
- 11% Ever used inhalants

Sexual Behaviors

- 42% Ever had sexual intercourse
- 12% Ever had four or more sex partners
- 30% Had sexual intercourse during the past three months
- 38% Did not use a condom during last sexual intercourse³
- **75%** Did not use birth control pills during last sexual intercourse³

Tobacco Use

- 60% Ever tried cigarette smoking
- 30% Smoked cigarettes during the past month
- **15%** Smoked cigarettes on \geq 20 days during the past month
- 15% Used smokeless tobacco during the past month
- 14% Smoked cigars during the past month

Dietary Behaviors

- 83% Ate < 5 servings of fruits and vegetables per day during the past 7 days</p>
- 76% Drank < 3 glasses of milk per day during the past 7 days


Physical Activity

- 38% Participated in insufficient vigorous physical activity⁴
- 74% Participated in insufficient moderate physical activity 5
- 73% Were not enrolled in physical education class
- 84% Did not attend physical education class daily
- **10%** Did not participate in any vigorous or moderate physical activity

Overweight


- 14% At risk for becoming overweight⁶
- 9% Overweight⁷
