## These risk behaviors 1...

## **Unintentional Injuries and Violence**

15% Rarely or never wore safety belts

23% Rode with a drinking driver during the past month

12% Carried a weapon during the past month

32% Were in a physical fight during the past year

12% Attempted suicide during the past year

#### Alcohol and Other Drug Use

42% Drank alcohol during the past month

27% Reported episodic heavy drinking during the past month

21% Used marijuana during the past month

8% Ever used cocaine

11% Ever used inhalants

#### **Sexual Behaviors**

42% Ever had sexual intercourse

13% Ever had four or more sex partners

30% Had sexual intercourse during the past three months

40% Did not use a condom during last sexual intercourse<sup>2</sup>

74% Did not use birth control pills during last sexual intercourse<sup>2</sup>

#### **Tobacco Use**

55% Ever tried cigarette smoking

22% Smoked cigarettes during the past month

11% Smoked cigarettes on ≥ 20 days during the past month

8% Used smokeless tobacco during the past month

14% Smoked cigars during the past month

#### **Dietary Behaviors**

NA<sup>3</sup> Ate < 5 servings of fruits and vegetables per day during the past 7 days

80% Drank < 3 glasses of milk per day during the past 7 days

## **Physical Activity**

32% Participated in insufficient vigorous physical activity 4

NA Participated in insufficient moderate physical activity 5

59% Were not enrolled in physical education class

68% Did not attend physical education class daily

NA Did not participate in any vigorous or moderate physical activity

13% At risk for becoming overweight<sup>6</sup>


