## THIRD QUARTER DRUG-RELATED DEATH STATISTICS RELEASED BY STATE MEDICAL EXAMINER

Statistics released today by the Oregon State Medical Examiner's Office indicate that despite a significant drop in heroin-related deaths, cocaine and methamphetamine-related deaths continue at high levels.

A total of 152 drug-related deaths were recorded during the first nine months of 2000, a 26% drop compared to the same period in 1999 and the lowest recorded level since 1995. Yet despite this noted decrease led by a 40% drop in heroin-related deaths, cocaine and methamphetamine use continues to result in deaths higher than any year prior to 1999.

Even though heroin-related deaths continues to be the leading cause, the 98 deaths attributed to its abuse reflected the lowest number of deaths since 1995 when 94 drug-related deaths were from the result of the use of heroin.

The second leading cause continues to be associated with cocaine use. Through September 2000, cocaine accounted for 48 deaths, down 19% compared to last year but still higher than any previous yearly period.

Drug-related deaths associated with methamphetamine remained unchanged from the same period last year. Through the first three-quarters of 2000, forty (40) people died related to methamphetamine use. This number equaled the same period last year, which was the highest recorded number up to that period.

Drugs used in combination with other drugs reflected a 34% decrease. Thirty-two (32)
