Highlighted Facts

- Louisiana has the fourth highest cardiovascular death rate in the nation.
- Cardiovascular disease is the leading cause of death in Louisiana, accounting for almost 40 percent of all death in the state (see the figure below).
- Louisiana African-American women have a 40% higher chance of dying of cardiovascular disease than white women.
- In 1999, cardiovascular disease claimed 15,522 people in Louisiana, approximately 45 a day.
 In 2000:
 - 23.6 % of adult Louisianans were obese.
 - 36.5 % of adult Louisianans were overweight.
 - Only 16 % of adult Louisianans were consuming at least five serving of fruits and vegetables daily.
 - 85% of adult Louisianans were inactive (did not engage in physical activity 30 minutes / day, 5 times a week).

- Actual Causes of Death in the United States, 2000 (Adobe PDF Free Viewer) CDC new study showing that the gap has narrowed between deaths due to poor diet and physical activity and those due to smoking. The study is based on data gathered through the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) and the National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey (NHANES.)
