

EHD's Plan to Improve Global Health

When it comes to improving public health, it's not just English speakers in America who need to learn about the link between prenatal and lifelong health. The urgent need for image-based prenatal education is also multilingual and global. For this reason, EHD has developed a plan called Project World, which will make our educational resources known and available internationally.

To address this huge challenge, we will develop DVD and Internet-based prenatal education resources in 93 languages. This will make prenatal education available to educators, clinicians, public health officials, and families all over the world. Project World has the potential to cost-effectively reach more than six billion people in their primary or secondary languages. It is perhaps the most affordable way to improve public health through prevention on a global scale.

In its essence, the first phase of Project World has three components:

- Preparation of the DVD and website
- Promotion to global leaders
- Partnership formation

The DVD component of this project will create subtitles and audio tracks for The Biology of Prenatal Development in all of our target languages. This will give the global community immediate access to the DVD on our website and prepare the DVD for international broadcast and distribution.

The website component will translate 125,000 words from www.ehd.org into each new language.

The promotion and partnership components will provide DVDs, introduce our other resources, and explain the benefits of prenatal education to key government, medical. and education leaders in virtually every country.

This unique project will leverage technology to save lives and improve health everywhere.

Prenatal Slideshows

Would you like to see snapshots of the embryonic heart and much more? Check out our 10 new prenatal slideshows made from our collection of more than 300 prenatal images.

If you are a registered educator, you can create your own custom slideshows by selecting a title, choosing and sorting the snapshots, and setting the default viewing parameters. Each custom slideshow receives its own unique web address, which can then be emailed or posted on a website, course page, social networking page, etc.

You may notice the image labels that help explain each snapshot. Once translated, these labels will be indexed by search engines in various languages, which will help web surfers around the world to find our website and images.

Movie Playlists

This section groups related video clips together in five ready-to-use playlists. For instance, you can watch The Heart in Action. Our other playlists are entitled: Prenatal Movement, Arms and Legs, Rarest Footage, and Facial Expressions. Registered educators can make custom playlists from our library of clips from the DVD and other sources.

Similar to the Prenatal Slideshows, each playlist has a unique web address, which can be shared via email or posted on a web server or a social networking site.

For the first time, you can enjoy full-screen video on our site (just download the latest free version of Adobe's Flash player). This is a great feature when showing clips to larger groups of friends and family at home or students at school.
